MASCOUTAH PUBLIC LIBRARY SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES DECEMBER 6, 2021

The Board of Trustees of the Mascoutah Public Library held a special meeting at the library on December 6, 2021 at 6:15 p.m.

RESOLVED: That this Board hereby approves and confirms the employment of Joel Pikora as Director of the Mascoutah Public Library, effective as of January 3, 2022.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That this Board hereby approves and confirms the following mutually agreed terms and conditions applicable to Joel Pikora's employment.

Salary: \$54,080

IMRF (Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund)

Fully paid health insurance for the Director only: \$14,952 per year

Twelve (12) holidays

PTO (Paid Time Off) 7.7 hours each pay period

Probationary Period - January 3, 2022 to May 1, 2022 with an evaluation by the Personnel Committee within the first few weeks of May, 2022. The report will be presented at the May 17, 2022 Library Board meeting.

No cell phone provided.

The Board thanked the Personnel Committee (Nancy, Roger, Kay and Marian) for its hard work and dedication during the search for a new Director.
